



2020 U.S. Kids Golf World Teen Van Horn Cup Red vs Blue

Congratulations on qualifying for the 2020 Teen Van Horn Cup, to be contested on Sunday, July 26th on Pinehurst No. 2. The Teen Van Horn Cup is a Team Four-Ball Stroke Play competition featuring the top players from each of the Boys and Girls age divisions. Please review the information below as you prepare for the event.

Sunday, July 26th Schedule

5:30 AM – 6:00 AM: Van Horn Cup Bag Pickup (Pinehurst Main Clubhouse Parking Lot)

6:00 AM: Player Continental Breakfast (The Deuce)

6:30 AM: Team Meeting with Captains on Veranda

6:45 AM: Team Introduction

7:00 AM: Warm up

7:30 AM: First tee time

Format: Four-Ball Stroke Play Competition

Two players play their better ball against the better ball of two other players. The team with the lowest stroke total after 18 holes will earn a point for their team. Matches that are tied will result in a ½ point for each team. If the teams are tied, a playoff will decide the Teen Van Horn Cup winner.

Team Selection Process

The Red and Blue teams will be formed via a random drawing. The drawing will take place on Saturday morning and teams will be announced.

Boys Divisions

The top eight players in each age group will qualify for the Teen Van Horn Cup. The names of all eight players will be drawn individually at random. The first two players drawn will be partners on the Red Team and the next two will be partners on the Blue Team. These players will compete against each other in the Red vs Blue format. This process will repeat for the next four players in the age group.

Girls Divisions

The top four players in each age group will qualify. The names of all eight players will be drawn individually at random. The first two players drawn will be partners on the Red Team. The last two players drawn will be partners on the Blue Team. These players will compete against each other in the Red vs Blue format.

Morrison Medal

Each year, the boys and girls pairings with the lowest rounds in the Teen Van Horn Cup are awarded a Morrison Medal. The award is named in honor of the late Sir Garth Morrison, who served as Lord Lieutenant for East Lothian, and his wife Lady Gill Morrison.
